<p>a. Universal and correct wearing of masks;</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Communicate effective face covering practices to all children and staff if needed. -Follow face-covering requirements set forth by the PA DOH and PDE. -Providing the correct face covering based on the child’s individual needs. -Follow any guidance provided by the Department of Human Services (DHS), Office of Children and Youth and Families (OCYF), and Juvenile Judges Court Commission (JCJC).
<p>b. Modifying facilities to allow for physical distancing (e.g., use of cohorts/podding);</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Follow the current CDC, PA DOH, and PDE guidelines for physical distancing. -Restricting tutoring sessions to one child per time. -Using outside resources to enhance learning. -Provide standard PPE for all staff and children upon request. -Visit restrictions for parents, county officials, and teachers. -The use of video conferencing for visitation. -The use of see through dividers when face-to-face is required. -Follow any guidance provided by the Department of Human Services (DHS), Office of Children and Youth and Families (OCYF), and Juvenile Judges Court Commission (JCJC).

Handwashing and respiratory etiquette;</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Follow the current CDC, PA DOH, and PDE guidelines for handwashing and respiratory etiquette. -Teaching children to effectively wash hands and stop the spread of germs. -The use of hand sanitizers anytime a child moves to a different room. -Placement of signs to encourage regular hand washing. -Teaching children to cough into their elbow to stop the spread of germs. -Using disposable paper towels to dry hands after washing. -Signage is posted in the facility to remind staff and children of proper hand washing techniques. -Follow any guidance provided by the Department of Human Services (DHS), Office of Children and Youth and Families (OCYF), and Juvenile Judges Court Commission (JCJC).
<p>d. Cleaning and maintaining healthy facilities, including improving ventilation;</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Follow the current CDC, PA DOH, and PDE guidelines for cleaning and ventilation. -The implementation of a daily sanitization protocol. This includes sanitization of all door handles, tables, and other high touch areas. -The addition of ionizers to our heating/cooling system to improve air quality. -The implementation of more paper products during meals/snacks to avoid the spread of germs.

Contact tracing in combination with isolation and quarantine, in collaboration with the State and local health departments;</p>	<p>-Follow the current CDC, PA DOH, and PDE guidelines for contact tracing, isolation, and quarantine.</p> <p>-Follow any guidance provided by the Department of Human Services (DHS), Office of Children and Youth and Families (OCYF), and Juvenile Judges Court Commission (JCJC).</p>
<p>f. Diagnostic and screening testing;</p>	<p>-Follow any current diagnostic testing and screening procedures required by the Department of Health (DOH).</p>
<p>g. Efforts to provide vaccinations to school communities;</p>	<p>-Follow any current diagnostic testing and screening procedures required by the Department of Health (DOH) in conjunction with parental consent or a court order.</p>
